NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Executive Session: RCW 42.30.140(4)(a) Collective bargaining sessions with employee organizations, including contract negotiations.
 - a. The Commissioners met for an executive session at 12:22pm, and would be meeting for 20minutes. The meeting resumed at 12:50pm and no action was taken during the executive session.
 - b. After resuming the meeting, Commissioner Pearsall made a motion to approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement for 2022-2023. Commissioner Hutchins seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

2. Budget update

- a. Chief Rux reviewed the draft updates to the 2022 Budget. It included seventh full-time position, a station alerting system in capital improvements, station 2 and training grounds improvements, and tree and brush clean-up, adding to apparatus replacement fund (to replace B13-1 next), and bunker gear replacement of \$150K (one time expenditure in 2022). Commissioner Hutchins asked about each station's roofs and Chief Rux said that the department is aware of their lifespan and that there was a plan to start replacing them in the next few years.
- 3. Proxy for WFCA Conference
 - a. Commissioner Hutchins made a motion to approve proxies for both Commissioner Hutchins and Pearsall, to allow Commissioner Black to vote at the WFCA Conference. Commissioner Pearsall seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

COMMENTS FOR THE GOOD OF THE ORDER

Chief Rux thanked the board for approving the CBA contract and for their support. He also mentioned that the department would be participating in the GNA Trunk or Treat at Griffin School, the GNA picnic and that Fire Prevention week at the Griffin School was a success.
